


How to Register

Our Story

We are a not-for-profit organization that has been providing recreation programs and services for all ages to the Maillardville community since 2001. Over the years, we have offered thousands of exciting, low-cost programs, serving over 50,000 registrants and accommodating over 350,000 visitations.

After 21 years of serving the community out of the facility on 1200 Cartier Street, our organization was unexpectedly removed from the site in 2022 when the City of Coquitlam opened their new Maillardville Community Centre. This left us homeless and scrambling for a new location and funding to survive.

Thanks to the generosity of our community partners, we were able to get back on our feet, but we have a long way to go to remain sustainable.

- Place Maillardville Society's office is now located in Maillard Middle School. Thank you to the Maillard Middle School Administration and School District #43 for their incredible ongoing support.
- Our After school programs, funded by the United Way of BC and partnered with SD43, is offered at Cape Horn, Rochester, Maillard Middle, Alderson and Lord Baden Powell schools.
- Our Youth Drop-in program, funded by BC Community Gaming Grants and partnered with SD43, is offered at Maillard Middle School.
- Our Seniors' programs, funded by BC Community Gaming Grants, are offered at Our Lady of Lourdes Church Hall.
- Our Family & Early Years programs, funded by the Ministry of Children and Family Development, are offered at the YMCA Child Care Resource Centre and Our Lady of Lourdes Church Hall.

The programs we now offer are a scaled back version of what we use to provide when we had more programming space and funding. Although the grants help provide some of the much-needed low-cost core programming, it does not provide for the basic administration costs to keep the Society sustainable.


